I am writing to express my objection to the proposed development at The Chelsfield, 1 Windsor Drive, Orpington BR6 6EY (Reference 18/04573/FULL1).

This development is entirely out of character with the surrounding area demolishes a historic building and landmark. I have spoken with local residents and councillors who are deeply concerned at the loss of the 1930s facade and the cherished interior of the pub, which includes a function room used by a number of local community groups. The proposed development would remove this community space and introduce a new convenience store, putting pressure on stores in the nearby parade.
